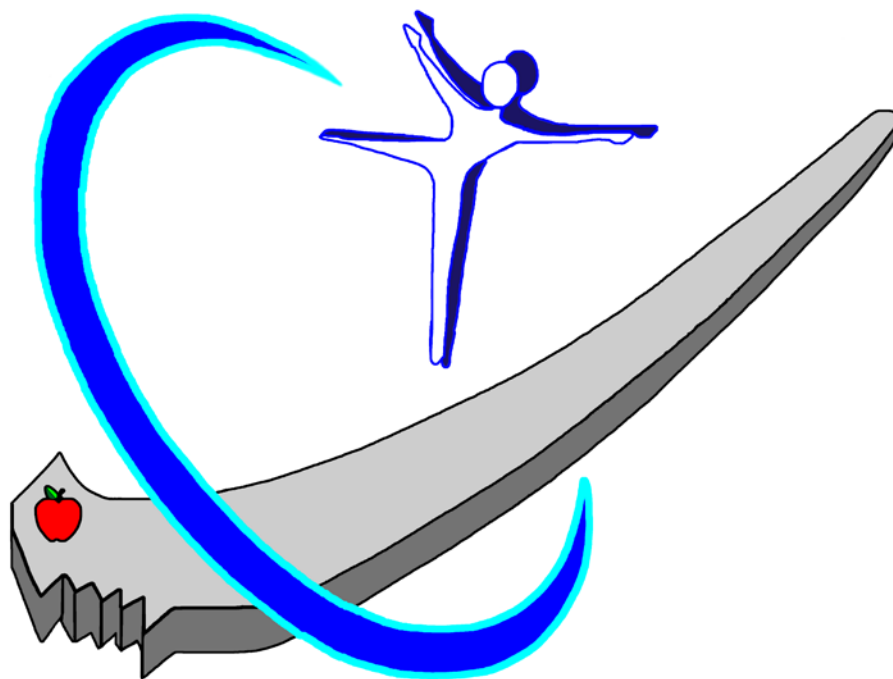

## ***Wenatchee Figure Skating Club Expectations***

These expectations are meant to promote a safe environment and enhance the skating experience for every skater. We are asking that all Club members read and sign these guidelines before taking to the ice.

- ❖ Skaters begin each session with warm-up stroking and stretch.
- ❖ The sessions are to be used to work on programs and improve skills.
- ❖ If you are not skating, please move to the side.
- ❖ Standing at the railing or wall is distracting. If skaters want to converse with parents and others, please leave the ice.
- ❖ When you fall and are uninjured, please get up as soon as possible so that you are not in the way of other skaters.
- ❖ Skaters may NOT kick the ice, throw snow or ice balls, play tag or engage in any other potentially dangerous activities. Skaters who disobey this rule will be asked to leave the ice.
- ❖ Spins should be done in the center of the ice. Jumps are to be done on the outside edges.
- ❖ A skater who has their music playing has the right of way. Other skaters must be aware who is skating and avoid interrupting their program. Armbands are available and can be used to identify the skater.
- ❖ The ice monitor will play the music. When you are ready for your music, please request that it be put in line and ask who is before you so that you will be prepared when it is your turn.
- ❖ Each CD will be played through. There is no stopping and re-starting unless there is a mechanical problem.
- ❖ Only coaches have the right to interrupt the music line-up. There will be no cutting ahead of others in line.
- ❖ Do not interrupt the skaters and coaches during private lesson times.
- ❖ Avoid following other skaters through their program, as this is distracting.
- ❖ Skaters need to be aware of other skaters around them and to not interfere with another skater's maneuvers. This could cause injury to both skaters.
- ❖ Please be respectful of all other skaters. Yelling at or using foul language is not allowed. If a Coach or Board Member sees this type of behavior, you will be asked to leave the ice.
- ❖ No inappropriate language or conversation is permitted. Please remember that there are small skaters who learn from what older skaters say and do.
